Good afternoon church!

Soon you will be able to go out to a restaurant (whatever that will look like) and visit your hair salon or your dentist. So when will we be able to return to worship? We've been asking that question a lot lately and more particularly, what will worship look like? While things may change over the upcoming weeks, the current guidance being provided does not sound like worship we have grown to know and love.

The timeline has not been established, but we do know that it will not be in May. When we gather for worship it will look and feel much different than what we used to experience. Imagine sitting six feet apart from anyone else except for your family members. And that is if you are under 60 years of age. Age 60 and above is considered elderly and it is recommended that the elderly not participate in public worship at this time, including elderly Pastors! Do you have your mask prepared for worship? And what will we do if we cannot serve Holy Communion? These and other guidelines are being debated by churches in Arizona using the guidelines from the CDC and the AZ Department of Health. Now, we do not have definitive guides as of yet, but you begin to see the picture of what we are looking at. We want to gather for public worship, but we also want to protect the health of our congregation and community. This will take a lot of planning but also a lot of prayer.



Most importantly, we want to keep you and all who come here for worship and Sunday School, for Preschool and Kindergarten safe and healthy!
