Hello Church,

I want to share a quick update with you on **Regathering for Public Worship**. As the positivity rate across Arizona and Maricopa County continue to decline, we are getting closer to the point of where we can once again gather for worship. Please stay tuned for an announcement after worship this Sunday!

In the meantime, I want to clarify some confusion about who should be coming to worship. The CDC changed their guidelines this summer and what they state is that "COVID health risks increase with age and for those with underlying health conditions". While we previously listed age requirements, we are choosing NOT to limit participation or service based on age. Please consider your health and make the choice that is right for you, your family and for your brothers and sisters in Christ. This guideline pertains to attending worship and to serving as a Worship Host.

This Sunday we will continue our look at ACTS 20:20 in 2020 as we continue to explore what it means to Worship in the Temple and from House to House. This week we will read Matthew 28:16-20 as we look at the question, "What is the Purpose of the Church?"

After worship this Sunday, Patti will meet at 11:00 with the older elementary aged children as she introduces them to a new online curriculum and they get reacquainted with one another. At Noon, I will meet with 6th, 7th and 8th graders and their parents as we discuss our plans for confirmation this year.
