PASTOR'S CORNER

Hello friends!

This Sunday we begin a new series (Conversations with the Prophets!) as we move into the season of Lent. Sunday's Scripture Mark 9:2-9 is the Transfiguration of Jesus. Jesus takes Peter, James and John up to Mt. Sinai (formerly known as Mt. Horeb) where he meets with Moses and Elijah and is transfigured in glory. One of the things that this story does not tell is what Jesus, Moses and Elijah talked about. We can assume that it might have been about fulfilling the Law (Moses) and the Prophets (Elijah), but we don't know. So, in the spirit of spiritual curiosity, we will look at some of the stories of Moses and Elijah to see if we can ascertain, why these two met with Jesus and what they might have to say to us today.





Livestream scripture readers needed!



Daily Texts 2021 are available!


