Yesterday was Ash Wednesday and we had beautiful weather which enabled us to gather outdoors for two brief services of ashes on the patio. My heart was so filled with joy at the sight of people whom I love that I hadn't seen for nearly a year – and also grief, over the realization of what we have lost this past year. But as I said last night in the Ash Wednesday message, God takes our brokenness, our failures, our loss of relationships – all of the things that separate us from God and one another and God begins to create something new. We don't know what it is or what it will look like, but we live into it trusting that God is still present and that we need the Good News of Jesus, perhaps, more than we ever have.

Some friends of mine, who are also Pastors shared their Ash Wednesday stories and there were some wild ones! In Minnesota and Wisconsin, standing outdoors, providing drive by ashes with liturgies to go in sub-zero temperatures. And I weep for my friends in Texas who spent their Ash Wednesday helping people find water, food and warm shelter. The people there are suffering so much – let us keep them in our prayers!

This Sunday we will look at I Kings 18:41-46 as Elijah prays for rain in the midst of a drought. Our theme is "Trusting God" which evokes thoughts of Jesus praying in the wilderness for 40 days and nights trusting God as Satan tempts him. As we enter this season of Lent, I invite you to join us on the journey—participating in the Daniel Plan—renewing our focus to be in prayer and in the Word and to look out for our neighbors and those who are in need.


