PASTOR'S CORNER

Good evening Church!

Elijah was discouraged and wanted God to just end his life so that he wouldn't have to suffer and worry about being killed by his enemies. When we as Christians become discouraged, confronted by fear, illness and division, we can begin to lose hope. It is helpful to be reminded that God has given us a promise for our most despairing moments.

Jesus said, "Take a lesson from the fig tree. From the moment you notice its buds form, the merest hint of green, you know summer's just around the corner. So it is with you: When you see all these things, you'll know he's at the door. Don't take this lightly. I'm not just saying this for some future generation, but for all of you. This age continues until all these things take place. Sky and earth will wear out; my words won't wear out." Matthew 24:32-35 The Message

Heaven and earth will pass away and when that day comes, the power of sin and the evil one will cease. Someday this world will pass away with all of its illnesses and diseases. This world will pass away with its sinful love of division. But what will not pass away is God's Word of Truth and Grace. God always has more for us than we can imagine. Bread and water revived Elijah and bread and wine will revive us.

Join us this Sunday as we look at the life of Elijah and what was to sustain him during one of his most difficult times. 
