The President and Governor ordered everything except essential work to be closed – we thought for 2-3 weeks. Well, one year later here we are still battling the virus, worshipping at home and maintaining our social distance with masks.

There is good news, however. I read this morning in the paper that Maricopa County now has 23% of the county vaccinated. That means that there is light at the end of the tunnel. In the not-too-distant future, we will be able to risk coming together again. We are monitoring the numbers and will keep you posted. In the meantime, we invite you to reserve a spot for our Easter Sunrise Service, live on the patio at 8:00 am Easter morning.

Some people desire only in-person worship services. Some need or want only streaming services. After we have moved out of the pandemic, we will offer both – in-person worship and online worship services. In order to do that well, we will need to upgrade our technology – our cable wire into the office and throughout the church campus – the equipment used to stream/record services – and the software that we use to present the service. This will be the primary focus of our Building Fund Drive this year. We will soon have the pledge card emailed to you. If you prefer a paper copy, you can print it from the website or let us know and we will mail it to you. Thank you for your prayerful consideration in giving to this special fund.

This week we will continue our "Conversations with the Prophets." Our Scripture will be about the complaints of the Israelites, snakes and a bronze snake on a pole (Numbers 21:4-9). It's quite a conversation, so I hope that you will join us!




