This Sunday, the 21st we will observe the 5th Sunday of Lent. It is the final week before we enter Holv Week. In order to assist your planning, let me share what our plans are for Holy Week. On Sunday, the 28th we will offer the Palm/Passion Service online via our streaming on Facebook Live. Later in the week, we will celebrate Maundy Thursday at 7:00 pm via Zoom. Patti and I will host this service in our home, in which we will celebrate Holy Communion. Last year we did this with Zoom outside our home, but the street noise was problematic – at least for us. So this year, we will lead the service from inside our home. We will stream Good Friday Service on Facebook Live at 7:00 pm. Then, on Sunday – Easter Morning – you will have two options. We will offer a live, in-person service on the patio at 8:00 am. Be sure to sign up to attend on Signup Genius, plan to bring your own chairs and join us as we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord. Then at 10:00 am, we will have our online streaming service on Fa**cebook Live.** Lots of options and opportunities - I hope you will mark your calendars and join us!

Back to this Sunday, we will conclude our series on "Conversations with the Prophets" as we look at Elijah's transferring of power to Elisha as he is taken up into heaven on a whirlwind. The chariots and horsemen and fire also fit into this story. What a fitting end to our Lenten Season. The question that burns in me is "Who are we teaching and apprenticing to take the reins of leadership from us when our time comes to be swept up into heaven?" Is it good enough to say, that's not my concern! Is the only thing that matters is that I know where I am going? As for the rest of you, you can fend for yourselves! It is tempting to find a way to get us all off the hook, but according to Jesus, we have a mission to do! Join me this Sunday as we explore 2 Kings 2: 1-15 and "the ascent of Elijah."




