PASTOR'S CORNER

Good evening dear friends,

This Sunday please join us as we celebrate with our 6th graders and 7th graders, Bible Presentation Sunday. We missed this annual event last year because we were not worshipping in person, so I am grateful that we are able to be together this year. Join us as we pray for these youth and for their parents who are fulfilling one of the baptismal promises.

I remember when I was a child, my home church sponsored a Vietnamese family and helped to resettle them. It was during the time of the end of the Vietnam war. As our US presence in Afghanistan has ended, we are being asked once again to show our love for our neighbor and to sponsor a refugee family. We will do this with three other Lutheran churches in the NE Valley. There will be a team of 8 coordinators, two from each church. They will meet and help to communicate the needs for a family that we will be asked to resettle. If you are interested in helping to lead this Refugee resettlement ministry, please let me know!

This Sunday, it is the Sunday that many of you have been waiting for. The book of Hebrews is more like a sermon than a letter. And in this sermon, the centerpiece is a comparison of Jesus with the High Priest Melchizedek. Now I have mentioned this King of Salem several times, but Sunday we will get the full story on just who Melchizedek was and how he became a forerunner of sorts to Jesus, the Great High Priest. If you are reading ahead, we have a longer text this Sunday. Look at Hebrews 7:1 – 8:13 and see if you can tell why I titled this message, "Melchizedek Who?"
