Jesus said a lot about love! "For God so loved the world..." "Love your neighbor..."! "Love your enemy..."! "Love each other..."! "Greater love has no man that this, that he would lay down his life for his friends!" Obviously, Jesus is not familiar with our nation and our culture today. If he was tuned into the world, he would most likely revise his teachings to sound more like this.

"Don't you know? You are supposed to despise your enemy and seek vengeance!" "You are to hate those who don't think like you do." "You are to loathe those who won't accept your world view." "And you are to love yourself and yourself alone." "If you don't watch out for number ONE no one else will. So, love yourself, your whole self and no one but yourself."

Thankfully, that is NOT what Jesus says: In one of his teachings about love, we will explore what it means to love like Jesus loves. This Sunday our scripture comes from Mark 12:28-34, where in response to a question from a Scribe, Jesus calls us to love God and to love our neighbor as we would love ourselves. And this word from Jesus 2000 years ago still stands true for us today. As we learned last Sunday in Hebrews,

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. So do not be attracted by strange, new ideas. Your strength comes from God's grace, not from rules ... which don't help those who follow them. Hebrews 13:9,10

Let's live in the grace of God and learn to love God and one another! I hope to see you this Sunday!
