As we celebrate Thanksgiving this year, I thought it might be beneficial to look at the 4th petition in the Lord's Prayer and Luther's explanation of it:

"Give us this day our daily bread"

What does this mean? Luther writes:

"In fact, God gives daily bread without our prayer, even to all evil people, but we ask in this prayer that God cause us to recognize what our daily bread is and to receive it with thanksgiving."

Who knew that Luther would have the insight to know that we might be gathering with family and friends, some of whom we might consider evil! What is implied here is that no matter how fair or unfair God's blessings seem to us, we ought to give thanks to God. So, no matter who you plan to have Thanksgiving dinner with – friend or foe – we are reminded to give thanks!

This Sunday is the first Sunday in Advent and our Commitment Sunday. We will see the Christmas tree beautifully decorated, the advent candles on the altar and a full morning of Word and Sacrament ministry. As a part of our worship, we will make commitments of our time, talents and finances for the ongoing ministry of New Covenant. The Scripture for the first Sunday in Advent is Luke 21:25-36. Even in the midst of the warnings, there is a clear message for us as Christians – Be Confident! Join us this Sunday for in-person worship at 10:30 am.
