What do you value about your church? Is it discipleship or God's Word? Perhaps it is acts of love and mercy or worship. One of the things that we will be doing as a church is re-evaluating our congregational values so that we can reaffirm them. Values help us to know how to live with one another and what is important to us as a body of Christ. Speaking of values, what are you doing for Valentine's Day?

Saint Valentine was a Priest or a Bishop (historians are not certain which) serving the Christian church in the Roman Empire during the 3rd century. His ministry was to care for persecuted Christians. This did not endear him to Rome, who had him put to death. He was martyred in the year 269 AD and buried on February 14th in a cemetery along the Via Flavinia (a road that led out of Rome on the coast of the Adriatic Sea). The 14th of February is a celebration of a life lived in devotion to God, serving God's people. So, Valentine's Day is a celebration of sacrificial love and commitment to others! Who is God calling you to serve on Valentine's Day?

This Sunday we will hear of Jesus preaching a sermon on the plain of the Sea of Galilee. Luke tells us that Jesus preached this sermon on the plain, as opposed to Matthew who said he preached it on the mountain. The sermon on the plain gets its name from this description in Luke: "on the way down from the mountain Jesus stood at a level place". Whether he was on the mountain or down from the mountain, what he preaches is a powerful sermon that seeks out the lost, the sinner, and the outcast. Join us as we look at Luke 6: 17-26 and unpack what it truly means to be happy!
